Utilizing Existing WRF Infrastructure for Nitrogen Removal in Manatee County

Before its conversion, Manatee County's Southwest Water Reclamation Facility (SWWRF) was a 15 million gallons per day (mgd), annual average daily flow (AADF) domestic wastewater plant, utilizing primary, secondary and tertiary treatment. The County proactively incorporated nutrient removal into this facility and converted the existing plant liquid stream treatment process to a Modified Ludzack-Ettinger (MLE) process to reduce total nitrogen (TN) to less than 10 parts per million (ppm). Soon after the MLE Process was implemented, the SWWRF observed TN levels below the target of 10 mg/L, a reduction up to 70% from the previous process.
