

Hillsborough County Public Schools extends a cordial invitation to you to serve as a judge for the Junior/Senior Division of the 46th Annual Hillsborough Regional Science Technology, Engineering and Mathematics (STEM) Fair. The 2026 HRSTEM Fair will be held at the Tampa Convention Center on February 17th and 18th, 2026. Judging for Junior/Senior Division will occur on Wednesday, February 18th between the hours of 10:30am and 2:30pm. A complimentary brunch will be provided by partners of HCPS at 9:30am and orientation will begin promptly at 10:00am. Judging will begin in teams at 10:30am.

The projects at the HRSTEM Fair represent students' work, which earned a place in a school-based STEM Fair. These students are looking forward to the regional competition and appreciate the time and effort each person contributes to make it a success. These videos feature participants of the International Science and Engineering Fair sharing their experiences with judging.

As you know, judges are the most important factor in a successful HR-STEM Fair because judging is the fundamental learning experience for our student participants. We hope you can help us provide quality experiences for our young people by lending your time and expertise in this worthwhile endeavor. Your assistance as a Regional Judge will be the primary vehicle in the selection of twenty-six projects that will represent Hillsborough County in the 2026 Florida State Science and Engineering Fair, where over \$200,000 worth of scholarships and awards will be provided to students.
